### **DAY 1: BARCELONA**

Welcome to Barcelona! Upon arrival you will be very welcome by your private and exclusive guide and transfer ALEJANDRO YEPES that will be with you for the whole Spanish Tour. Transfer to the Hotel, Introductions and meeting to go through the whole itinerary together while relaxing with a cup of tea.

### **CAMP NOU FC BARCELONA SATADIUM**

In the evening we will visit the FC Barcelona Museum, which is divided into several areas. In the Trophy Room, you'll see the different trophies won by Barça, including the Champions League, the National League Championships, and the King's Cups.

You can also visit the history area of the museum, which is focused on Barça's past. There's also the Messi Space, which is dedicated to Leo Messi, one of the best footballers of all time. And, finally, you can explore the Trophies Section, which houses the trophies won by the various branches of Barça in basketball, field hockey, and other sports.



### **BARCELONA-TOURS**

#### **Sagrada Familia & Towers Guided Tour**

Explore Barcelona's iconic symbol during a 2-hour guided tour with fast track entry and climb to the top of one of its 65-meter-tall towers to enjoy a magnificent bird's eye panoramic view of the city.

## **DAY 2: BARCELONA**

- **Skydiving activity (OPTIONAL)**

- Technical introduction prior to the jump
- • Anchor securely to the instructor
- • 15 min. of flight in one of our planes
- • Jump at 4000 meters of height
- • One minute of pure adrenaline in freefall
- • Free fall at a speed of 200 km/h
- • 4 to 5 minutes of parachute flight
- External camera video record



- After lunch we will do a **Private guided tour to Santa Maria de Montserrat** and Royal Basilica, La Moreneta. After admiring some incredible views, we'll arrive at the Montserrat Sanctuary. This place is well-known for its rocky surroundings and is considered a place of worship due to the miraculous apparition of the Virgin Mary in one of the mountain's caves.
- In Montserrat, meaning "mountain saw" in Catalan, we'll visit the Basilica, which houses the beautiful twelfth-century 'Virgen Moreneta', Catalonia's patron saint. For centuries, this temple was one of Spain's most popular pilgrimage sites.
- After the guided tour, you'll have some free time to enjoy the scenery and visit the local farmers' market. We'll then finish return to the Hotel.

### **DAY 4: VALENCIA**

- **PRIVATE TOUR TO THE NATIONAL TRUST PARK LA ALBUFERA**

I'll pick you up from the hotel at the agreed time and head to the Albufera Natural Park, just 10 kilometers away from Valencia.

Did you know Albufera is Spain's biggest lake? Our first stop will be in El Saler to admire some dunes and marvel over the endemic plants, as well its beach and the Mediterranean sea.

We'll continue our route taking in a spectacular panoramic view from the Gola de Puchol pier while we tell you all about its unique Mediterranean ecosystem.

Then, we'll head to El Palmar. This island of the **Albufera** (meaning 'lagoon' in Valencian) encapsulates its fishing roots that have characterized this area of Valencia throughout history. There are still some 18th-century houses!

We'll walk around the main streets, pass by monuments and enjoy a 15-20 minute boat ride to admire the area's delights from a different perspective, making four stops along the way.

- **Private Tour around the City Center**

- First, you'll make your way to Plaça de la Mare de Déu, also known as Plaza de la Virgen, one of the city's most famous squares. Here, your guide will reveal the fascinating history of the Tribunal of Waters, a tradition which has taken place every Thursday for several centuries.
- You'll also discover curious secrets surrounding the Fallas, one of Valencia's most important festivals, which has been declared an Intangible Cultural Heritage by UNESCO.
- Continue your walking tour around the old town to the Palau de la Generalitat, a building with Medieval origins, and the 14th century Miguelete, or Micalet Tower, one of the most iconic symbols of Valencia. Admire the Silk Exchange, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture and a symbol of the city's importance as an economic centre in the Middle Ages.
- Next, you'll make your way to the Central Market, where your senses will be delighted by the sight and smells of the different local delicacies on offer at the many food stalls that fill the beautiful Modernist building. Finally, wander over to the Serrans Gate, a striking Valencian Gothic style monument that formed part of the 14th century city walls.

#### **DAY 5: VALENCIA - GRANADA**

**(optional visit to Granada as there are too many km and time for just one night, otherwise we can go directly to Madrid and Visit more in detail the Capital City of Spain)**

- After breakfast we will start our journey to Granada that would take around 6h to arrive to admire one of the most beautiful monuments in Spain "La Alhambra" that we will visit in the early evening upon arrival after the Hotel checkin.

- **Alhambra + Albaicin Guided Tour**

- Like many writers, artists and intellectuals over the centuries, you're sure to be captivated by the awe-inspiring architecture and atmosphere of the jewel in the crown of Al-Andalus, the Alhambra. The UNESCO World Heritage Site was the royal palace-fortress of the Nasrid Kingdom of Granada and an incredible example of Islamic art. The Alhambra is one of the most visited monuments in Spain, and for good reason. The stunning walled palace complex dates back largely to the 13th and 14th centuries, and is home to some of Europe's most beautiful examples of Islamic architecture. Admire the intricately carved stonework and the complex geometric designs of the numerous courtyards, labyrinthine hallways and elegant gardens.
- Visit the main buildings and monuments of the Alhambra, including the Medina, the Alcazaba, the Generalife Gardens and the Palacios Nazaries: Mexuar, the Comares Palace and the iconic Court of the Lions.

- **Flamenco Show at La Soleá**

- La Soleá is a flamenco tablao located in the bullring. You'll get there for 10 pm to walk through the doors and find yourself immersed in the world of flamenco and the most deep-rooted Andalusian culture. Are you ready for an evening like no other?
- Take a seat, make yourself comfortable and prepare yourself to witness one of the most lively flamenco shows in Spain. Male and female flamenco dancers will then step onto the stage to star in "Zambra, La Raíz" and perform a heartfelt rendition of the most characteristic Spanish art.
- For 1 hour 15 minutes, you'll be taken in by the different palos of flamenco and the expressive singing, guitar strumming, dancing, hand-clapping and foot-stamping that's sure to leave a lasting impression.
- Dinner at La Soleá Menu included
- Dinner is served 30 minutes before your chosen show time.
